Graduation

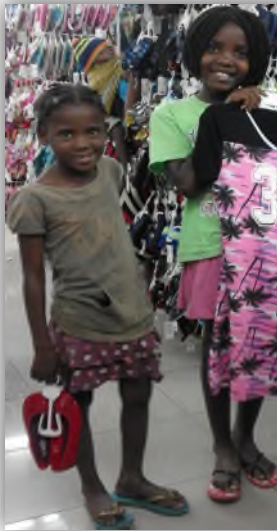
We ended our year with a very good graduation, parents are very supportive and always looking forward to this special event for their children.
